**AN APPEAL**

Dear Students,

Therefore, you must express your choice by exercising your voting right to elect responsible and responsive representatives, who can act as an effective interface between you and the administration, besides ensuring a peaceful environment, conducive for academic and professional development. Quoting from Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam's appeal, which he made in 2004, "The right to vote is a sacred right and onerous responsibility that you owe to the motherland, hence, exercising your franchise must become a priority activity for you and you should cast your vote positively".
