## NOTIFICATION

### Reference: Second Phase- Mock Test (OBE)

In continuation of the notification issued on July 15, 2020 vide Ref. No. Dean(Exams)/2020 regarding the conduct of the Open Book Examination (OBE) for the final semester/term/year students of all Undergraduate and Post Graduate Courses from 10.08.2020 in compliance of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi on 14.07.2020 in W.P.(C) No. 3199/2020, the University shall conduct Mock Test to make the students familiar with the procedure of OBE. The Mock Tests shall be conducted in two phases.

*As already notified vide Ref. No. Dean(Exams)/2020 on July 15, 2020 the second phase of mock tests will be based on real version and single paper of each program of final semester/year of undergraduate and postgraduate programmes of current batch.*

The following points may be noted regarding the **Second Phase** of Mock Test to be conducted for the Undergraduate Courses and Post Graduate Courses (Regular, NCWEB and SOL):

1. The **Second phase** of Mock Tests will be conducted from **01.08.2020 to 04.08.2020**.
2. The tests will be conducted for the Undergraduate courses in three sessions on all the four days as per the details provided below:

3. The details of papers to be given for the Mock Test will be as per details below:

**For Undergraduate Courses (CBCS)(Details of papers to be given for the Mock Test):**

- B.A(Prog.)/B.A Vocational/B.Voc. – Generic Elective papers (VI Semester)
- B.A.(Hons.)/B.Com.(Hons)/B.Sc.(Hons)/and all UG/Professional courses(SDC)– Core papers(VI Semester)
- B.Sc. Physical Science/B.Sc. Mathematical Science/B.Sc. Applied Physical Science – Mathematics (VI Semester)
- B.Sc. Life Science/B.Sc. Applied Life Science – Chemistry (VI Semester)
- B.Sc. (Pass) Home Science- Nutritional Biochemistry

**For Ex-Students of Three Year Semester Scheme (2014)**

The ex-students of B.Sc.(Hons.)/B.A.(Hons.)/B.Com.(Hons.) will attempt the question paper of B.Sc.(Hons.)/B.A.(Hons.)/B.Com.(Hons.) of CBCS VI semester respectively.

**For Ex-Students of Erstwhile FYUP (2013)**

The ex-students of B.Tech. will attempt the question paper meant for B.Sc.(Hons.) VI Semester of respective discipline under the CBCS scheme.

4. The Mock Tests for the **Post Graduate Courses** will be conducted from **01.08.2020 to 04.08.2020** between **10:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.** The students of Final year will appear for the tests as per the datesheet and will attempt the question paper as available on the portal. The Ex-Students will attempt the question paper of respective PG courses.

**NOTE: 1. *Students are advised to appear for Second Phase of Mock Test as per schedule/datesheet meant for Second Phase of Mock Test as notified on University website including SOL and NCWEB on the respective portals.***

**2. *Answer scripts as uploaded by the students are only for practice purpose and shall not be evaluated.***

**3. *All ex-students of CBCS, Three Year Semester Scheme (2014) and Erstwhile FYUP (2013) shall also attempt the question papers for the mock test as given for the regular students of the current batch of CBCS (VI semester) as notified.***

5. The students appearing for the Mock Test will use the link as already notified on 02.07.2020 vide Ref. No. Dean (Exams.)/2020 and reiterated as below:

6. The students appearing for the second phase of Mock Test will follow the steps as below:

STEP 1: Self registration to the DU portal (if not registered yet).

STEP 2: You will receive a password on registered mobile/e-mail (if not registered yet).

STEP 3: Login with the examination roll no. and password to locate the mock test paper.

STEP 4: Download the question paper on your computer/phone through a click on the Question paper (can take a printout if required)


STEP 5: Write down your answer on a plain or ruled paper (letter or A4 size) with a blue or black pen. Write down your name, course, semester, roll no. , paper details, date and time of examination on the first sheet. Please write down page number at the bottom middle of the page, so that you maintain the sequence of the pages and also the total count of pages.

STEP 6: Please scan all the pages one by one (DO NOT MAKE ONE FILE OF MULTIPLE PAGES OR ALL ANSWERS) and upload each of the pages as a separate file. Each single scan file should not exceed 5MB of the size (only PDF and JPG formats are allowed.) You can upload multiple files for each question.

STEP 6: Please ensure all the files are uploaded and check the status. If your file is not uploaded successfully, try again and upload, this may happen due to connection break or sudden break of internet connectivity.

STEP 7: Once all the answer pages are uploaded, SUBMIT and close your examination.

STEP 8: Logout.
